



"YOU MELT MY HEART"

5½" tall snowman ornament
that's sure to melt your heart!

SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR EACH

- * Two 7" x 5" pieces of tan flannel.
- * One ½" x 18" torn strip of green fabric for scarf.
- * One 1" square of orange/brown fabric for nose.
- * Crochet Thread size #20 - Black & a Chenille Needle.
- * One 2" square of red fabric for heart & ⅝" green button.
- * Powdered blush & cotton swab.
- * White Glue & Hot Glue with gun.
- * Fiberfill.
- * Fishline.

TO MAKE SNOWMAN

1. Fold orange/brown nose material in half to form a triangle. Apply a couple dabs of white glue and roll, from one corner across fabric, to form nose. Re-apply glue if necessary to hold nose's shape. Allow to dry, trim to desired length.
 2. Layer your 5" x 7" pieces of tan flannel fabric with **right** sides together. Trace Snowman's shape on the **wrong** sides of your layered fabric - **do not** cut out.
 3. Machine-stitch on traced lines - **do not** leave an opening. Cut out, leaving a scant 1/8" seam allowance.
 4. Cut a slit on the back side of the Snowman as noted on pattern. **Cut through one layer of fabric only.** Turn right side out. Stuff with fiberfill through the back opening. Whip-stitch opening closed without over-lapping fabric edges.
 5. Trace or free-hand the saying "You Melt My Heart" or any other saying you'd like with a water-soluble marker.
 6. Thread your Chenille needle with your black crochet thread and knot the end. From the back of the body, stitch through to the front, then stitch saying and mouth using a back-stitch (it is not necessary to stitch all the way through the body with each stitch). Once saying is finished, stitch through to the back of the body, tie off and knot to secure.
 7. Make two one-loop French-knots for eyes and one long straight stitch for each eyebrow. Position and glue nose in place (white glue works best). Arrange the ½" x 18" torn strip around neck and tie into a bow; trim to desired length.
 8. Cut out one heart from your 2" square of red fabric and Country-Stitch in place. Embellish with button, hot glue or stitch in place.
- Note: If desired you can tea-stain your Snowman - steep 1 standard size tea bag in boiled water, cool slightly; using the tea bag, dab Snowman to reach desired effect. Allow to dry.
10. Position dried nose and hot glue in place. Apply powdered blush with a cotton swab.
 11. Make a hanger out of an 8" piece of fish-line by stitching through the back of the Snowman's head and tying ends together.
